## 4. **TEACHER PRESENTED SEMINARS FOR BENEFIT OF TEACHERS & STUDENTS**

### 1. **Seminar on Rehabilitation of child in need of care and protection [HOPE]**

On **30th March 2023**, Dr. Sicily A A, Assistant Professor at St. Joseph College of Teacher Education for Women, Ernakulam, presented a seminar on "Rehabilitation of Child in Need of Care and Protection [HOPE]" to all faculty of the college. The seminar began with an introduction to the concept of child in need of care and protection (CNCP). Dr. Antony explained that CNCPs are children who have been abused, neglected, or exploited. She also discussed the different types of CNCPs and the legal framework that protects them. The next part of the seminar focused on the rehabilitation of CNCPs. Dr. Sicily A A discussed the different approaches to rehabilitation, including residential care, foster care, and family-based care. She also discussed the importance of providing emotional and psychological support to CNCPs. The final part of the seminar was a question-and-answer session. Dr. Antony answered questions from the faculties about the seminar topics and about her work with CNCPs.

### 2. **Orientation for Portfolio Preparation**

The event is conducted by the Optional Teachers at the Classroom of St. Joseph College of Teacher Education for Women, Ernakulam on annual basis enabling students to create effective portfolios. On 19/11/2022, from 3PM till 4.30PM optional teachers-oriented portfolio preparation for the BEd students.

### 3. **Seminar on FIACS**

The seminar on FIACS was held on **9th November 2022** at St. Joseph College of Teacher Education for Women, Ernakulam from 10AM till 12 PM in the multipurpose hall. The seminar was conducted by Anu Cleetus, Assistant Professor at the college for all B.Ed students. The seminar began with an introduction to FIACS. Mrs Anu Cleetus explained that FIACS stands for Flanders Interaction Analysis Categories System. It is a system developed by Ned Flanders in the 1960s to analyze classroom interaction. The seminar was followed by a demo class by a student teacher and interaction analysis of the class by other teacher trainees.
