RESEARCH POLICY DOCUMENT



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RESEARCH POLICY

St. Joseph College of Teacher Education for Women envisages a learned Society that paves way for improvement through Educational Research.

For the institution, Educational Research is important because it improves teaching and learning practices, reforms educational policies, addresses educational challenges, promotes innovation, ensures evidence-based decision-making, and contributes to the broader body of knowledge.

Objectives of Research Policy

This is what we aim at:

1. to help educators to refine their teaching methods and create more engaging and effective learning environments through research,
2. to help policymakers and education administrators to take decisions about curriculum design, assessment strategies, school organization, and resource allocation based on our research findings and outputs .
3. to help educational institution to implement evidence-based practices that promote student achievement and educational equity by relying on research,
4. to identify and address critical challenges arising in the education system.
5. to investigate issues such as achievement gaps, inclusiveness, student motivation, school climate, classroom management, special education, and the integration of technology in education and to develop interventions, strategies, and programmes to overcome obstacles and improve educational outcomes.
6. to encourage innovation and the development of new ideas in teaching and learning by exploring emerging trends, theories, and technologies in the same.



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7. to challenge and encourage educators to think outside the box to improve educational practices by extending the boundaries of knowledge, and by fostering creativity through research.
8. to contribute to the broader field of knowledge by generating new insights, theories, and perspectives which would add to the collective understanding of human learning, cognitive processes, and educational systems.
9. to elaborate its knowledge creation, through multidisciplinary, AI based researches in the field of Education addressing the problems of individualisation and inclusiveness.

Custodian of the Policy

The implementation and updating of the research policy is carried out by the Director, Research Cell. The Research Policy shall also have a Research Advisory Cell to function under the Principal, St. Joseph College of Teacher Education for Women, Ernakulam to assist and advise in matters related to research within the college.

Research Policy

The Institutional Research Policy serves for encouraging and inspiring its Faculty and the Student Community- the Aspiring Research Scholars and the Research scholars to undertake research and further research for the growth and development of the Nation.

1. **Promoting a Research Culture:** Research policy of the institution help establish and promote a culture of research within the institution. It acts as a framework and guideline for conducting research activities, encouraging faculty, staff, and students to engage in research pursuits.

Policy Statement:

- The Institution shall have a Research Cell with the Principal as its Head, a Senior Research Guide as its Director and three more senior Faculty (Preferably Research Guides of the institution, approved by Mahatma Gandhi University).



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- The Institution shall have a Research Advisory Committee, which includes all the faculty members of the institution who have acquired their Doctorate degree in field of Education.
- The term of office of a Research Cell is for two years.
- The Research Cell shall ensure the quality and proper documentation of the Research works carried out in the institution.
- Every Year, The Research Cell will organize at least one International or National Seminar or Conference with theme that promotes Educational Research.
- Clearly communicate the institution's expectations regarding research activities and their importance to all the students (B.Ed., M.Ed., Research Scholars and Faculty members every year). Ensure that these expectations are disseminated to newly appointed faculty, staff, and students who are freshers.
- The institution will provide seed money for research projects and doctoral studies of the faculty members subject to the research work undertaken and recommendation of research cell and approval of the Head of the institution.
- The faculty members can avail study leave for research purpose without affecting normal functioning of the institution and subject to recommendation of Research cell and approval of Head of the Institution.
- All students pursuing research in the college are expected to maintain high standards originality in respect of all the work undertaken by them.

2. **Ensuring Ethical Conduct:** Our Research policy outline ethical standards and guidelines that researchers must adhere to. They must ensure that the research is conducted with integrity, protecting the rights and well-being of research participants.

Policy statement:

- The policy demands the researchers of the institution to follow principles regarding informed consent, confidentiality, data protection, and adherence to ethical guidelines set by regulatory bodies like UGC, NCTE, and MG University.



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- Since the college is affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam, the college follows the regulations of the University and UGC regarding plagiarism and malpractice in research.
- A Ph. D. thesis submitted from the Institution is screened by Mahatma Gandhi University, for plagiarism before it is accepted. Regarding paper publications, each student can avail the facility in the university to check for plagiarism.
- The Research Cell should ensure that the researchers undergo institutional level plagiarism checking before submitting the Thesis to the MG University. For this the PG students and the Research Scholars can avail the facility for Plagiarism Checking provided in the college Research centre and Library.
- Any sort of research misconduct, including fabrication, falsification, and plagiarism will not be allowed.

3. **Research Guidance and Research Projects:** Research policies help the institution to establish criteria and processes for securing research grants, managing research budgets, and distributing resources among research projects.

Policy statement:

- The faculty must apply for funded research projects every year and undertake projects.
- Teachers who are already Ph.D holders have to be encouraged for post-doctoral researches.
- The faculty of the institution is advised to publish articles only in UGC care listed Journals, or journals indexed in approved and high-quality data bases.
- Faculty members who have doctorate degree in Education should meet the requirements for being approved research guides in the Research centre of the institution in accordance with UGC and University norms.



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4. **Supporting Collaboration and Interdisciplinary Research:** Research policies often encourage collaboration and interdisciplinary research initiatives. They may provide mechanisms and incentives to promote interdisciplinary collaboration among researchers from different departments or disciplines.

Policy Statement:

- The Institution has to sign up more MOUs with reputed institutions in various disciplines, that help to contribute new collaborative knowledge to the field of Education.
- The college has to undertake appropriate research activities in collaboration with the institutions with which we have already signed the MOUs, so that a collaborative research culture will be maintained in the campus.

These may include guidelines for human subjects research, animal research, intellectual property, conflicts of interest, and research integrity. 6. **Enhancing Research Productivity and Impact:** Well-defined research policies can contribute to enhancing research productivity and impact.

- Each and every faculty who is given a chance to guide the M.Ed thesis must publish an article together with the Teacher Educand in the Institutional Peer reviewed Journal EDUFOCUS.
- Any Research finding or contribution of the institution can be presented in the public, seminar or conferences only after getting prior sanction from the college authority and research director.

7. **Updation of Research Facilities in the Institution:** The research policy also helps to maintain the standards of the physical instructional upgradation of research facilities provided by the Institution.

National Library and Information Services Infrastructure for Scholarly Content

A project funded by the Ministry of Human Resource development (MHRD) under its National Mission on Education through ICT



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Background

The Project entitled "National Library and Information Services Infrastructure for Scholarly Content (N-LIST)", being jointly executed by the UGC-INFONET Digital Library Consortium, INFLIBNET Centre and the INDEST-AICTE Consortium, IIT Delhi provides for i) cross-subscription to e-resources subscribed by the two Consortia, i.e. subscription to INDEST-AICTE resources for universities and UGC-INFONET resources for technical institutions; and ii) access to selected e-resources to colleges.

The N-LIST Project provides access to e-resources to students, researchers and faculty from colleges and other beneficiary institutions through server(s) installed at the INFLIBNET Centre. The authorized users from colleges can access e-resources and download articles required by them directly from the publisher's website once they are duly authenticated as authorized users through servers deployed at the INFLIBNET Centre.

N-LIST: Four Components

The Project has four distinct activities and components, i.e. i) to subscribe and provide access to selected UGC-INFONET e-resources to technical institutions (IIMs, IITs, IISc, IISERs and NITs) and monitor its usage; ii) to subscribe and provide access to selected INDEST e-resources to selected universities and monitor its usage; iii) to subscribe and provide access to selected e-resources to all Govt. aided/non- aided colleges and monitor its usage; and iv) to act as a Monitoring Agency for colleges and evaluate, promote, impart training and monitor all activities involved in the process of providing effective and efficient access to e-resources to colleges.

The INDEST AICTE Consortium, IIT Delhi and UGC-INFONET Digital Library Consortium, INFLIBNET Centre are jointly responsible for activities listed at i) and ii) above. The INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar is responsible for activities listed at iii) and iv) above. The INFLIBNET Centre is also responsible for developing and deploying appropriate software tools and techniques for authenticating authorized users.

Beneficiary Institutions

The following three sets of institutions are benefitting from the N-LIST Project:

- I. Universities: 100 universities covered under the UGC-INFONET Digital Library Consortium can now access Web of Science.
- II. Technical Institutions: IITs, IISc, IISERs and selected NITs (i.e. core members of the INDEST-AICTE Consortium) can now access selected e-resources namely Annual Reviews, JSTOR, Project Muse, Nature and Taylor & Francis.
- III. Colleges: All colleges including Govt., Govt.-aided as well as non-aided colleges (except colleges imparting education in agriculture, engineering, management, medical, pharmacy, dentistry and nursing) can now access selected electronic resources including electronic journals, electronic books and bibliographic databases. These resources include more than 6000+ e-journals and 97,300+ e-books.

Resources Subscribed for the Colleges

Beneficiary colleges, registered for the N-LIST project, can access more than 6,000+ electronic journal, 97,300+ electronic books and a bibliographic database called MathSciNet containing more than two million reviews of research articles in mathematics. Infrastructure Required @ Colleges

Colleges should have adequate number of Internet-enabled PCs and connectivity to Internet so as to access e-resources through N-LIST.

Request an Article through NLIST- ILL

The N-LIST Project has initiated Inter Library Loan (ILL) services for the benefit of users from colleges enrolled under the NLIST Project. All faculty, staff and students from member colleges are welcomed to use this service and request journal articles and chapters from books that are not available through resources subscribed under the N-LIST Project. The requests for articles can be sent online using Online ILL Request form available on the N-LIST website (<http://nlist.inflibnet.ac.in/article/>). This service is free of charge. Users are required to log-in with their username ID and password to request articles using N-LIST ILL Service. The username ID and Password for ILL requests are the same that have been provided to the users for accessing N-LIST resources.

Current Status

As on 1st July, 2013, a total number of 3,357 colleges have registered themselves with the N-LIST Project including 3,055 Govt. / Govt.-aided as well as non-aided colleges. Log-in username ID and password for accessing e-resources has been sent to the authorized users from these 3,055 colleges. All e-resources subscribed for colleges under the N-LIST Project are now accessible to all eligible colleges through the NLIST website (<http://nlist.inflibnet.ac.in>). Total no. of registered users have grown to 4,84,939.

Training and Support

The INFLIBNET Centre conducts awareness and training programmes in various universities to generate awareness regarding availability of e-resources to colleges under the N-LIST Project. Besides, universities are also being encouraged to conduct awareness training programmes for its affiliated colleges. Besides, N-LIST website host online tutorials, user guide and spoken tutorials for e-resources covered under the project.
