**Outreach activity in Collaboration with Ernakulam District Administration,
Government of Kerala: Mass Survey and Volunteer in various Flood Relief activities in
Kadamakudy Panchayat, Ernakulam district.**

The magnitude of Disaster caused in the recent floods of August 2018 was unprecedented in the History of Kerala. The disaster crippled the lives and livelihoods of people. Rebuild Kerala was an initiative of the Government of Kerala to rebuild the state after the disaster. The aim of the initiative was to bring about a perceptible change in the lives and livelihoods of its citizens by adopting higher standards of infrastructure for recovery and reconstruction, and to build ecological and technical safeguards.

The first challenge before the Government was to collect information from the local people about their loses during the flood. St. Joseph College was intended for smooth and efficient fulfilment of this task that our state Kerala much needed in the aftermath of flood that affected the lives of hundreds of thousands of people in our neighborhood. Josephites helped the Government to identify the people and their needs after the flood disaster, by conducting a mass survey at Kadamakudy Panchayat in Kanayannur Taluk.

In response to the flood disaster that hit our state, the students from our college volunteered for a Mass Online Survey named Rebuild Kerala, of the Government of Kerala. The volunteers visited the houses in Kadamakudy Panchayat on 11th, 12th, 13th and 14th September 2018, and collected information regarding the damage caused by flood. Each volunteer received a certificate of appreciation from the District collector, Ernakulam and from the Kadamakudy Panchayath.

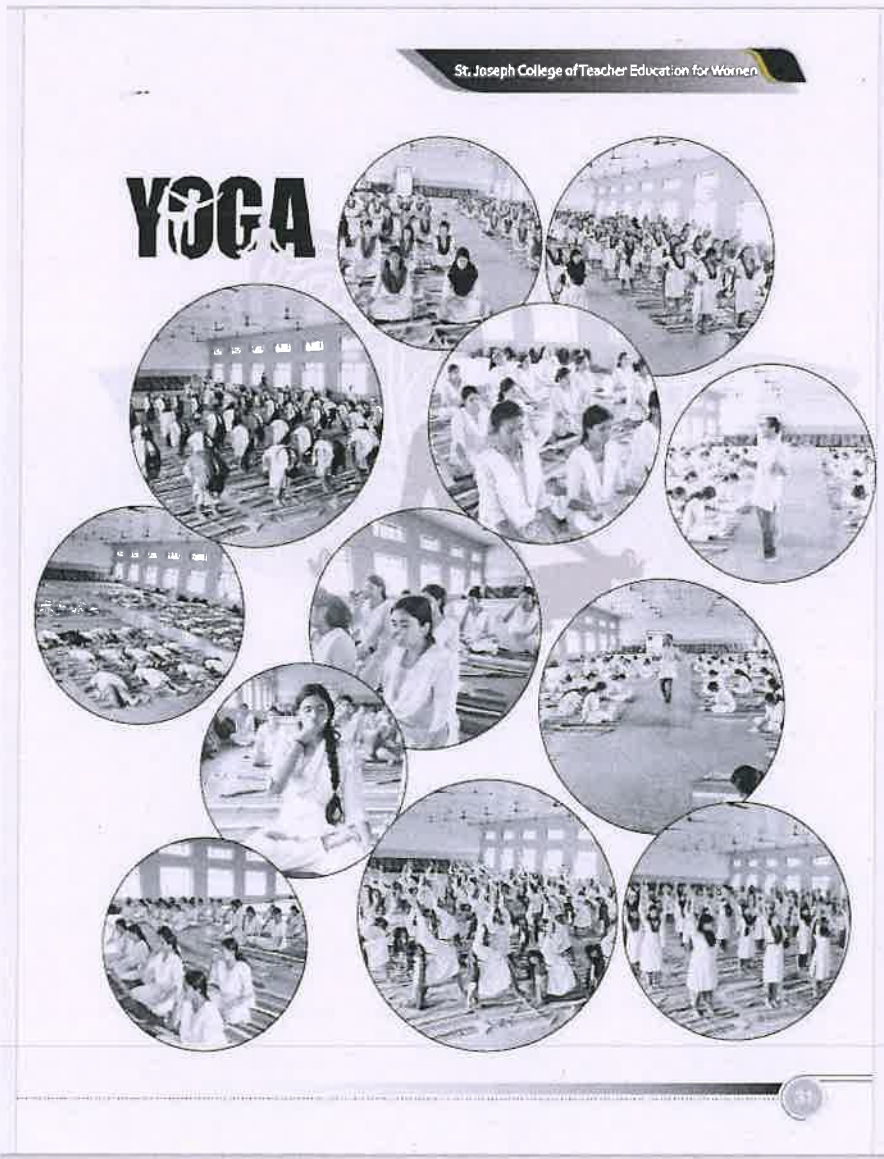

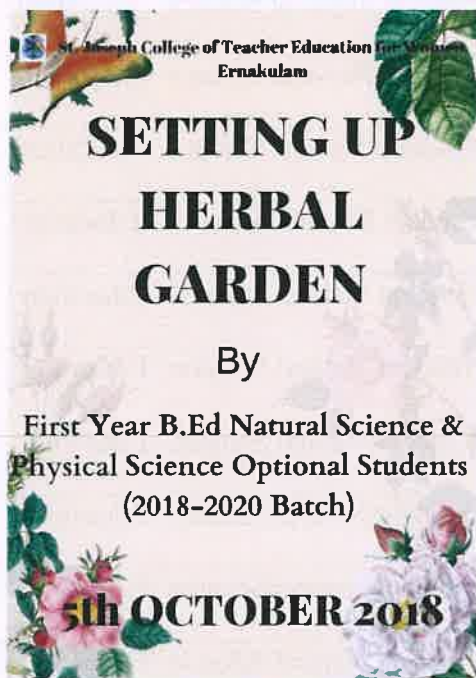
